On Saturday, June 14th, the Rural Agri-Innovation Network (RAIN), a project of the Sault Ste. Marie Innovation Centre (SSMIC) and NORDIK, will host the first annual Eat Algoma. Local Food Festival.

With the theme “farm to fork,” this unique northern Ontario food festival will celebrate local food, farming and food traditions in Algoma. The festival will educate consumers about healthy food options and serve as a unique opportunity to connect Algoma’s food community.
